
CABINETS

Cabinets, which are available in single, double and half-height configurations, are widely used for herbarium, entomology, geology, and specimen storage applications. Cabinets can be adapted with fixed compartments, drawers, flat files or adjustable shelving. Other options and accessories can be added to enhance the standard offering.



ART RACKS

Art racks provide a convenient compact solution for storing hanging artwork. The art rack system is suspended from an overhead beam that can either be mounted to an existing ceiling structure or to a self-contained overhead metal structure provided by Borroughs. The pull-out racks allow for convenient, multiple-rack access.



DRAWERS

Drawers provide an excellent flat storage solution for preserving art pieces or specimens. Borroughs drawers are available with continuous handles or handle pulls and can be designed and built to a wide range of width, depth, and height specifications. They can be incorporated into a freestanding unit, configured into a cabinet or as part of a shelving range. For small artifact storage applications, drawers can come with slotted interiors for configurable drawer dividers. Pull-out trays, which utilize slotted tray runners permanently welded into the cabinets, are easily removed for specimen work.

When the American Museum of Natural History in New York City needed to move its mammalogy specimen collection into a smaller space, it required a better, more efficient storage solution. The museum incorporated [⊕]Paramount[™] products on high-density carriages.
